In this chapter, "veteran" means 10 an individual who: 11 (1) has served on active duty in the armed forces of 12 the United States; and (2) was honorably discharged from military service. 13 14 Sec. 23.002. VOLUNTARY PREFERENCE POLICY. (a) A private employer may adopt a policy under which the employer may give a 15 16 preference in employment decisions regarding hiring, promotion, or 17 retention to a veteran over another qualified applicant or employee. 18 (b) A policy adopted under this section must be in writing. 19 Sec. 23.003. APPLICATION OF POLICY. (a) A private employer 20 shall apply any policy adopted under this chapter reasonably and in 21 good faith in employment decisions regarding hiring, promotion, or 22 23 retention during a reduction in the employer's workforce. 24 (b) A private employer may require appropriate

3 (c) Granting a preference in accordance with a policy 4 adopted under this chapter does not violate Chapter 21.

5 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 6 to an employment decision made on or after the effective date of 7 this Act. An employment decision made before the effective date of 8 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the decision 9 was made, and the former law is continued in effect for that 10 purpose.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
