## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to prohibition of notification forms from health benefit plan issuers intended to intimidate patients; adding a provision 3 subject to a criminal penalty. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 843.363, Insurance Code, is amended by 6 7 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows: (a-1) A health maintenance organization may not, as a 8 9 condition of payment with a physician, dentist, or provider, or in any other manner, require a physician, dentist, or provider to 10 provide a notification form stating that the physician, dentist, or 11 provider is not a participating provider to a current, prospective, 12 or former patient, or a person designated by the patient, if the 13 form contains additional information that is intended, or is 14 otherwise required to be presented in a manner that is intended, to 15 16 intimidate the patient. SECTION 2. Section 1301.067, Insurance Code, is amended by 17 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows: 18 19 (a-1) An insurer may not, as a condition of payment with a physician or health care provider or in any other manner, require a 20 physician or health care provider to provide a notification form 21 stating that the physician or health care provider is not a 22 23 preferred provider to a current, prospective, or former patient, or

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a person designated by the patient, if the form contains additional

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- 1 information that is intended, or is otherwise required to be
- 2 presented in a manner that is intended, to intimidate the patient.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
