If unanimous consensus cannot be reached among the 13 14 representatives, (c-1) In allocating among eligible institutions money 15 available for initial grants for an academic year, the coordinating 16 board shall establish the amount of funds eligible for the public 17 state colleges and public technical institutes as eight percent of 18 the total amount appropriated.
