A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to a pilot program in certain school districts exempting
- 3 those districts from administering standard assessment instruments
- 4 and authorizing alternative assessment instruments.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 39, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 39.042 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 39.042. ALTERNATIVE ASSESSMENT INSTRUMENTS PILOT
- 9 PROGRAM. (a) The commissioner by rule shall develop and implement
- 10 <u>a pilot program under which participating school districts are</u>
- 11 <u>exempt from administering assessment instruments under Section</u>
- 12 <u>39.023</u> and administer alternative assessment instruments.
- 13 (b) A school district may apply to the commissioner to
- 14 participate in the pilot program established under this section.
- 15 The commissioner shall select for participation in the pilot
- 16 program one school district located in each of the regional
- 17 education service center areas. To be eligible to apply for the
- 18 pilot program under this section, a school district must have a
- 19 student enrollment of 70,000 or more. If a regional education
- 20 <u>service center area does not have a school district with student</u>
- 21 enrollment of 70,000 or more, the commissioner shall select the
- 22 district in the area with the highest student enrollment that has
- 23 applied for participation in the pilot program.
- 24 (c) A school district selected by the commissioner as a

- 1 participant in the Texas High Performance Schools Consortium under
- 2 Section 7.0561 may not participate in the pilot program established
- 3 under this section.
- 4 (d) The commissioner by rule shall adopt procedures to
- 5 designate alternative assessment instruments that may be used by a
- 6 school district participating in the pilot program to evaluate
- 7 student achievement. The procedures adopted by the commissioner
- 8 must provide that the following assessment instruments may be
- 9 administered by a participating school district as an alternative
- 10 <u>assessment instrument:</u>
- 11 (1) ACT Plan;
- 12 (2) Iowa Test of Basic Skills (ITBS);
- 13 (3) National Assessment of Educational Progress
- 14 (NAEP);
- 15 (4) Program for International Student Assessment
- 16 (PISA);
- 17 (5) PSAT; and
- 18 (6) Texas Success Initiative (TSI Diagnostic Test).
- 19 (e) From funds appropriated for that purpose, the
- 20 commissioner by rule shall establish a grant program under which
- 21 participating school districts receive grants to implement the
- 22 pilot program to administer alternative assessment instruments.
- 23 <u>(f) A school district that receives a grant under this</u>
- 24 section may use grant funds to implement an alternative system of
- 25 <u>student assessment using commissioner-approved alternative</u>
- 26 assessment instruments.
- 27 (g) Each participating school district shall report to the

- 1 agency student performance on alternative assessment instruments
- 2 the district administers under the pilot program.
- 3 (h) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to
- 4 administer this section.
- 5 SECTION 2. The commissioner of education shall establish
- 6 the pilot program under Section 39.042, Education Code, as added by
- 7 this Act, not later than September 1, 2015.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
