5	SECTION 1. Section 351.101, Tax Code, is amended by adding
6	Subsection (h) to read as follows:
7	(h) In addition to the uses authorized by Subsection (a), a
8	municipality described by Subsection (a)(7)(B)(viii), as added by
9	Chapter 546 (S.B. 585), Acts of the 83rd Legislature, Regular
10	Session, 2013, may use revenue derived from the tax authorized by
11	this chapter to promote tourism and the convention and hotel
12	industry by constructing, maintaining, or expanding a
13	sporting-related facility owned by the municipality if:
14	(1) the majority of the events at the facility involve
15	participants staying at hotels in the municipality; and
16	(2) for a fiscal year, the municipality does not
17	reduce the amount of that revenue that it uses for a purpose
18	described by Subsection(a)(3) to an amount that is less than the
19	<pre>lesser of:</pre>
20	(A) the amount of that revenue used by the
21	municipality for that purpose during the municipality's 2015 fiscal
22	year; or
23	(B) the total amount of that revenue received in

the fiscal year.
