A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-22 relating to the use of municipal hotel occupancy tax revenue in 1-23 certain municipalities. 1-24

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 351.101, Tax Code, is amended by adding 1-26 Subsection (h) to read as follows:

(h) In addition to the uses authorized by Subsection (a), a municipality described by Subsection (a)(7)(B)(viii), as added by 1-27 1-28 Chapter 546 (S.B. 585), Acts of the 83rd Legislature, Regular 1-29 1-30 Session, 2013, may use revenue derived from the tax authorized by this chapter to promote tourism and the convention and hotel industry by constructing, maintaining, or expanding a 1-31 1-32 а 1-33 sporting-related facility owned by the municipality if:

(1) the majority of the events at the facility involve 1-34 1-35 participants staying at hotels in the municipality; and

1-45 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-46 1-47 1-48 1-49 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
