- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 37.081, Education Code, is amended by
- 5 adding Subsection (i) to read as follows:
- 6 (i) The commissioner may develop programs to assist school
- 7 district peace officers in the performance of their duties,
- 8 <u>including information systems programs to promote improved</u>
- 9 collection and dissemination of information for the purpose of
- 10 school safety and violence prevention, including situational
- 11 awareness.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 37.084, Education Code, is amended by
- 13 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 14 (b-1) The commissioner may provide access to appropriate
- 15 data systems to assist in the collection of records for the purpose
- 16 of school safety and violence prevention.
- 17 SECTION 3. Subchapter D, Chapter 37, Education Code, is
- 18 amended by adding Section 37.1031 to read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 37.1031. ASSISTANCE FOR PROTECTION OF FACILITIES. The
- 20 commissioner may provide assistance to school peace officers and
- 21 other law enforcement agencies for the protection of school
- 22 facilities.
- SECTION 4. Section 37.108, Education Code, is amended by
- 24 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

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- 1 (e) The commissioner may provide school districts, public
- 2 junior college districts, and other law enforcement agencies access
- 3 to data and information management systems to aid in preparation of
- 4 the multihazard emergency operations plan in such a manner as to
- 5 <u>improve school safety and violence prevention.</u>
- 6 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
