- 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter J, Chapter 2306, Government Code, is
- 8 amended by adding Section 2306.233 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 2306.233. PREDEVELOPMENT GRANTS. (a) The department
- 10 may issue to a non-profit community housing development
- 11 organization certified by the department a project-specific
- 12 predevelopment loan to facilitate the development of a project
- 13 that, if considered feasible, will receive an award of financial
- 14 assistance under the terms of the federal HOME Investment
- 15 Partnerships Program established under Title II of the
- 16 Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act (42 U.S.C.
- 17 Section 12701 et seq.).
- 18 (b) A predevelopment loan issued under this section may not
- 19 be used to pay:
- 20 (1) project costs that exceed customary and reasonable
- 21 project preparation costs; or
- 22 (2) administrative expenses of a community housing
- 23 development organization.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter F, Chapter 2306, Government Code, is

- 2 Sec. 2306.11141. NOTICE OF COMPLETION OF ENVIRONMENTAL
- 3 REVIEW. Not later than the 90th day after the date of completion of
- 4 an environmental review required for an award of financial
- 5 assistance under the terms of the federal HOME Investment
- 6 Partnerships Program established under Title II of the
- 7 Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act (42 U.S.C.
- 8 Section 12701 et seq.), the department shall provide notice of the
- 9 completion and results of that review to the applicant for the
- 10 financial assistance and provide technical assistance to the
- 11 applicant, as may be necessary, to satisfy any deficiency as may be
- 12 noted during the review process.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
