A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to use and allocation of municipal hotel occupancy tax
3	revenues for certain municipalities.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 351.101, Tax Code, is amended by adding
6	Subsection (i) to read as follows:
7	(i) In addition to the purposes provided by Subsection (a),
8	a municipality that has a population of at least 75,000 but not more
9	than 95,000 and that is located in a county that has a population of
10	more than 160,000 but less than 200,000 may use revenue from the
11	municipal hotel tax to promote tourism and the convention and hotel
12	industry by constructing, operating, or expanding a sporting
13	related facility or sports field owned by the municipality, if the
14	majority of the events at the facility or fields are directly
15	related to a sporting event in which the majority of participants
16	are tourists who substantially increase economic activity at hotels
17	in the municipality.
18	SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 351, Tax Code, is amended
19	by adding Section 351.1078 to read as follows:
20	Sec. 351.1078. ALLOCATION OF REVENUE: CERTAIN
21	MUNICIPALITIES. (a) A municipality that spends municipal hotel
22	occupancy tax revenue as authorized by Section
23	351.101(a)(7)(B)(ii) or (i):
24	(1) may not use municipal hotel occupancy tax revenue

- 1 for the acquisition of land for the sports facility or sports fields
- 2 described by those provisions;
- 3 (2) shall annually determine and prepare a report on
- 4 the events held at the facility or fields, the number of hotel room
- 5 nights attributable to events held at the facility or fields, and
- 6 the amount of hotel revenue and municipal tax revenue attributable
- 7 to the sports events and tournaments held at the facilities or
- 8 fields for five years after the date the construction, operation,
- 9 expansion, or upgrade expenditures are completed; and
- 10 (3) may only spend hotel occupancy tax revenue for
- 11 operational expenses of the facility or fields if the costs are
- 12 directly related to a sporting event in which the majority of
- 13 participants are tourists who substantially increase economic
- 14 activity at hotels in or near the municipality.
- 15 (b) The municipality shall reimburse to the municipality's
- 16 hotel occupancy tax revenue fund from the municipality's general
- 17 fund any expenditure in excess of the amount of area hotel revenue
- 18 attributable to the construction, operation, expansion, and
- 19 upgrade of the sports facility or sports fields described by
- 20 Sections 351.101(a)(7)(B)(ii) and (i).
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
