- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 4101, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subchapter F to read as follows:
- 7 SUBCHAPTER F. PROHIBITED CONDUCT
- 8 Sec. 4101.251. CERTAIN [ROOFING] CONTRACTOR-RELATED
- 9 BUSINESS PROHIBITED. (a) An insurance adjuster licensed under
- 10 this chapter may not adjust a loss related to [roofing] property
- 11 damage on behalf of an insurer if the adjuster is a [roofing]
- 12 <u>contractor</u> or otherwise provides [roofing] <u>contracting</u> services
- 13 for compensation, or is a controlling person in a [roofing]
- 14 contracting-related business.
- 15 (b) A [roofing] contractor may not act as an adjuster or
- 16 advertise to adjust claims for any property for which the
- 17 contractor is providing or may provide [roofing] services,
- 18 regardless of whether the contractor holds a license under this
- 19 chapter.
- 20 (c) The commissioner shall adopt rules necessary to
- 21 implement and enforce this section.
