4	SECTION 1. Section 62.003(1), Education Code, is amended to

- 7 E, F, [and] G, and H, "eligible institution" means the eligible 8 agencies and institutions of higher education listed in Article 9 VII, Section 17(b), of the Constitution of Texas, and any

- 12 Article VII, Section 17(c), of the Constitution of Texas.
- 13 SECTION 2. Chapter 62, Education Code, is amended by adding 14 Subchapter H to read as follows:
- SUBCHAPTER H. TEXAS WATER RESEARCH PROGRAM
- Sec. 62.151. PURPOSE. The Texas Water Research Program is
 established to support and incentivize:
- 18 (1) research by eligible institutions regarding
- 19 innovative water conservation and reuse programs aimed at
- 20 increasing the viable water supply in this state and decreasing the
- 21 cost of new technologies; and
- 22 (2) public policy research by eligible institutions on
- 23 the existing water policy regulatory framework aimed at identifying
- 24 and making recommendations for improvements and clarifications to

- 1 state law and administrative rules.
- 2 Sec. 62.152. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
- 3 (1) "Eligible institution" means an institution of
- 4 higher education that:
- 5 (A) is designated as a research university or an
- 6 emerging research university under the coordinating board's
- 7 <u>accountability system; or</u>
- 8 (B) is determined by the Texas Water Development
- 9 Board as having the ability to successfully complete a research
- 10 proposal submitted for funding under the program.
- 11 (2) "Institution of higher education" has the meaning
- 12 assigned by Section 61.003.
- 13 (3) "Program" means the Texas Water Research Program.
- 14 Sec. 62.153. PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION. The coordinating
- 15 board, in collaboration with the Texas Water Development Board,
- 16 shall develop and administer the Texas Water Research Program in
- 17 accordance with this subchapter to provide annual grants to
- 18 eligible institutions for research proposals selected by the Texas
- 19 Water Development Board as best serving the purposes of the
- 20 program.
- Sec. 62.154. FUNDING. (a) The program is funded from the
- 22 amounts appropriated or transferred to the credit of the program
- 23 under this section or other law.
- 24 (b) The coordinating board may accept gifts or grants from
- 25 any public or private source for the program.
- Sec. 62.155. RULES. (a) The coordinating board shall adopt
- 27 rules for the administration of this subchapter.

- (b) The Texas Water Development Board shall adopt rules for the merit-based selection by the board of grant recipients under the program, including rules establishing the metrics by which research proposals will be measured in that selection process.
