COMPUTER SCIENCE DEVELOPMENT PILOT PROGRAM. 8 9 (a) The commissioner by rule shall develop and implement a pilot program under which: 10 11 (1) students in participating school districts may 12 comply with the curriculum requirements for the third mathematics credit under Section 28.025(b-1)(2) or the third science credit 13 under Section 28.025 (b-1)(3) by successfully completing an 14 advanced com<u>puter science course;</u> 15 16 (2) participating school districts implement rigorous standards, as developed by the commissioner, for computer science 17 courses that are focused on the creation and use of software and 18 19 computing technologies; and (3) classroom teachers employed by participating 20 school districts have increased opportunities to become certified 21 22 as computer science teachers. 23 (b) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to 24 administer this section.

1 (c) This section expires July 1, 2020.

2 SECTION 2. The commissioner of education shall establish 3 the pilot program under Section 28.018, Education Code, as added by 4 this Act, not later than September 1, 2015.

5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
