A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 relating to the development of a statewide motor vehicle

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 411, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 411.0094 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 411.0094. MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION PROGRAM. (a)
- 9 The department shall develop a statewide motor vehicle registration
- 10 program to help prevent transnational motor vehicle theft. The
- 11 department may not implement the program unless the legislature
- 12 subsequently provides by general law for the implementation of the
- 13 program.
- 14 (b) Under the program, an owner of a motor vehicle may
- 15 register the motor vehicle with the department to authorize a peace
- 16 officer to stop the registered vehicle before the vehicle crosses
- 17 the international border of this state.
- 18 <u>(c) The department shall develop a form to register a motor</u>
- 19 <u>vehicle under the program. The form must advise the owner of the</u>
- 20 motor vehicle regarding the provisions of Subsection (f). A motor
- 21 vehicle may not be registered under the program unless the owner
- 22 consents to the provisions of Subsection (f).
- 23 (d) The program must provide a method for an owner to
- 24 withdraw a motor vehicle from the program. The program may not

- 1 require an owner of a motor vehicle to participate in the program.
- 2 (e) After implementation of the program, the department
- 3 shall maintain a database of all motor vehicles registered under
- 4 the program.
- 5 (f) A peace officer who observes a motor vehicle that is
- 6 registered under the program and is crossing the international
- 7 border of this state may stop the motor vehicle to determine whether
- 8 the motor vehicle is being operated by the owner or with the owner's
- 9 permission.
- 10 (g) The department shall propose rules to administer the
- 11 program and may propose a registration fee in an amount sufficient
- 12 to recover the cost of administering the program.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
