- 14 Sec. 438.052. WARNING SIGNS REQUIRED FOR PEANUT
- CONTAMINATION. A food service establishment described by Section 15
- 16 438.051 shall post a sign in a conspicuous place in the area in
- which food is consumed that states the following: 17
- "This establishment prepares items that contain peanut 18
- products. Regular kitchen operations involve shared cooking and 19
- preparation areas. Therefore, we cannot guarantee that any item 20
- will be completely free of peanuts." 21
- Sec. 438.053. RULES. The executive commissioner of the 22
