- 4 SECTION 1. Section 2157.007, Government Code, is amended to

- 6 Sec. 2157.007. CONSIDERATION OF CLOUD [ADVANCED
- 7 INTERNET-BASED] COMPUTING SERVICE PURCHASE. (a) "Cloud [Advanced
- 8 Internet-based] computing service" has the meaning assigned by
- 9 Special Publication 800-145 issued by the United States Department
- 10 of Commerce National Institute of Standards and Technology, as the
- 11 <u>definition existed on January 1, 2015</u> [means a service that
- 12 provides network access to a shared pool of configurable computing
- 13 resources on demand, including networks, servers, storage,
- 14 applications, or related technology services, that may be rapidly
- 15 provisioned and released by the service provider with minimal
- 16 effort and interaction. The term does not include
- 17 telecommunications service or the act of hosting computing
- 18 resources dedicated to a single purchaser].
- 19 (b) A state agency may consider cloud [advanced
- 20 Internet-based] computing service options, including any cost
- 21 associated with purchasing those service options, when making
- 22 purchases for a major information resources project under Section
- 23 2054.118.
- 24 (c) A state agency shall ensure that information resources

- 1 projects that use $\underline{\text{cloud}}$ [$\underline{\text{advanced}}$ Internet-based] computing
- 2 service options meet or exceed required state standards for
- 3 cybersecurity.
- 4 (d) Using existing resources, the department may review the
- 5 process for the coordinated development, hosting, and management of
- 6 computer software for state agencies that use cloud [advanced
- 7 Internet-based] computing services.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
