- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 623.301, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 623.301. OPTIONAL PROCEDURE. This subchapter provides
- 8 an optional procedure for the issuance of a permit by the Port of
- 9 Corpus Christi Authority for the movement of oversize or overweight
- 10 vehicles carrying cargo on a state highway special freight corridor
- 11 located in San Patricio County or Nueces County.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 623.302(2), Transportation Code, is
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 (2) "Special freight corridor" means a highway built
- 15 by this state specifically for the movement of oversize or
- 16 overweight vehicles carrying cargo in San Patricio County or Nueces
- 17 County to and from the port authority's:
- 18 <u>(A)</u> La Quinta terminal; or
- 19 (B) Joe Fulton International Trade Corridor.
- SECTION 3. Section 623.303, Transportation Code, is amended
- 21 to read as follows:
- Sec. 623.303. ISSUANCE OF PERMITS. The Texas
- 23 Transportation Commission may authorize the port authority to issue
- 24 permits for the movement of oversize or overweight vehicles

- 1 carrying cargo on state highway special freight corridors located
- 2 in San Patricio County or Nueces County. The port authority may
- 3 issue a permit under this subchapter only if the cargo being
- 4 transported weighs 125,000 pounds or less.
- 5 SECTION 4. Section 623.306(a), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A permit issued under this subchapter must include:
- 8 (1) the name of the applicant;
- 9 (2) the date of issuance;
- 10 (3) the signature of the manager of transportation of
- 11 the port authority;
- 12 (4) a statement of the kind of cargo being
- 13 transported, the maximum weight and dimensions of the equipment,
- 14 and the kind and weight of each commodity to be transported;
- 15 (5) a statement of any condition on which the permit is
- 16 issued;
- 17 (6) a statement that the cargo may only be transported
- 18 to and from the port authority's:
- 19 (A) La Quinta terminal in San Patricio County
- 20 using a state highway special freight corridor in San Patricio
- 21 County; <u>or</u>
- 22 (B) Joe Fulton International Trade Corridor in
- 23 Nueces County using a state highway special freight corridor in
- 24 Nueces County; and
- 25 (7) the location where the cargo was loaded.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
