- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 132, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 132.025 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 132.025. TUITION AND FEE REIMBURSEMENT FOR CERTAIN
- 9 ADOPTED STUDENTS FORMERLY IN FOSTER OR OTHER RESIDENTIAL CARE. (a)
- 10 In this section, "institution of higher education" has the meaning
- 11 assigned by Section 61.003.
- 12 (b) Using funds appropriated for that purpose, the
- 13 commission, in coordination with the Texas Higher Education
- 14 Coordinating Board, by rule shall establish a program under which
- 15 the commission may reimburse a student for the payment of tuition
- 16 <u>and fees to a career school or college if the student would be</u>
- 17 eligible for an exemption from the payment of tuition and fees to an
- 18 institution of higher education under Section 54.367.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with tuition and fees
- 20 charged by a career school or college for the 2015-2016 academic
- 21 year.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
