A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to the requirement that a person or laboratory that 1-18 1-19 performs an official equine infectious anemia test be approved by 1-20 the Texas Animal Health Commission. 1-21

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 161, Agriculture Code, is amended by adding Section 161.0602 to read as follows:

Sec. 161.0602. PERSONS OR LABORATORIES PERFORMING EQUINE INFECTIOUS ANEMIA TESTS. (a) The commission shall adopt rules that require a person or laboratory to be approved by the commission if the person or laboratory performs an official equine infectious anemia test.

Rules adopted under this section must include: (b)

(1) approval requirements;(2) provisions governing the issuance, renewal, and

revocation of an approval;
(3) inspectio

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inspection requirements;

(4) recordkeeping requirements;

(5) equine infectious anemia testing methods approved by the commission; and

(6) proficiency standards.
SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2015, the Texas Animal 1-38 1-39 Health Commission shall adopt rules as required by Section 161.0602, Agriculture Code, as added by this Act.
SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015. 1-40 1-41

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
