9	from service, and inspection of equipment used by the public in:
10	(1) buildings owned or operated by the state, a
11	state-owned institution or agency, or a political subdivision of
12	the state; and
13	(2) buildings that contain equipment that is open to
14	the general public, including a hotel, motel, apartment house,
15	boardinghouse, church, office building, shopping center, or other
16	commercial establishment.
17	SECTION 2. Section 754.015(d), Health and Safety Code, is
18	amended to read as follows:
19	(d) The executive director may charge a reasonable fee as
20	set by the commission for:
21	(1) registering or renewing registration of an
22	elevator inspector;
23	(2) registering or renewing registration of a
24	contractor;

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1 day after the date on which an inspection is made under this
2 chapter;

3 (4) display the certificate of compliance for the
4 equipment in a publicly visible area as defined by commission rule;
5 and

6 (5) maintain the equipment in compliance with the 7 standards and codes adopted under commission rules.

8 SECTION 4. As soon as practicable after the effective date 9 of this Act, the Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall 10 adopt the rules necessary to implement the changes in law made by 11 this Act.

12 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
