A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to the issuance of a concealed handgun license to certain
3 retired judicial officers.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 411.201(a), Government Code, is amended
6 by amending Subdivision (2) and adding Subdivision (3) to read as
7 follows:

8 (2) "Federal judge" means:
9 (A) a judge of a United States court of appeals;
10 (B) a judge of a United States district court;
11 (C) a judge of a United States bankruptcy court;
12 or
13 (D) a magistrate judge of a United States
14 district court.

15 (3) "Retired judicial officer" means:
16 (A) a visiting ~~[special]~~ judge appointed under
17 Section 26.023 or 26.024; ~~[or]~~
18 (B) a senior judge designated under Section
19 75.001 or a judicial officer as designated or defined by Section
20 75.001, 831.001, or 836.001; or
21 (C) a retired federal judge who is a resident of
22 this state.

23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
3 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
