(C) a retired federal judge, who is a resident of 1 2 this state. 3 (C-1) "Federal judge" means: 4 (1) a judge of a United States court of 5 appeals; 6 (2) a judge of a United States district 7 court; 8 (3) a judge of a United States bankruptcy court; or 9 10 (4) a magistrate judge of a United States 11 district court. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

16 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
