## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the methods and procedures used by the comptroller to
- 3 determine the total taxable value of property in each school

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 403.302(a), Government Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a) The comptroller shall conduct a study using comparable
- 9 sales, appraisals, and generally accepted auditing and sampling
- 10 techniques to determine the total taxable value of all property in
- 11 each school district. The study shall determine the taxable value
- 12 of all property and of each category of property in the district and
- 13 the productivity value of all land that qualifies for appraisal on
- 14 the basis of its productive capacity and for which the owner has
- 15 applied for and received a productivity appraisal. The
- 16 comptroller shall make appropriate adjustments in the study to
- 17 account for actions taken under Chapter 41, Education Code.  $\underline{\text{The}}$
- 18 comptroller shall make available to the appraisal district that
- 19 appraises property for the school district the comparable sales and
- 20 appraisals used in the study that are not confidential under law.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
