1 AN ACT 2 relating to providing certain persons with resources for notifying the voter registrar of a death and related procedures. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 16.031, Election Code, is amended by 5 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as 6 7 follows: The registrar shall cancel a voter's registration 8 (b) immediately if the registrar: 9 (1) determines from information 10 received under 11 Section 16.001(c) that the voter is deceased; 12 (2) has personal knowledge that the voter is deceased; 13 receives from a person related within the second (3) 14 degree by consanguinity or affinity, as determined under Chapter 573, Government Code, to the voter a signed [sworn] statement by 15 16 that person indicating that the voter is deceased; or (4) receives notice from the secretary of state under 17 18 Section 18.068 that the voter is deceased. (c) The secretary of state shall prescribe and make publicly 19 available a form that a person may use to make a statement under 20 21 Subsection (b)(3). The form must: 22 (1) state that the person submitting the form must be 23 related to the deceased person within the second degree by consanguinity or affinity, as determined under Chapter 573, 24

1 Government Code; 2 (2) require the person submitting the form to sign the 3 form; and 4 (3) require the person to provide enough information 5 to enable the voter registrar to distinguish the deceased person 6 from any other registered voter. 7 SECTION 2. Section 651.201(a), Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows: 8 9 (a) The commission shall prepare a brochure with information of public interest: 10 11 explaining matters relating to funerals; [and] (1)12 (2) describing: the functions of the commission; and 13 (A) 14 (B) the commission's procedures for filing and 15 resolving a public complaint; and 16 (3) informing persons that a voter registrar must 17 cancel a voter's voter registration if a person related to the voter within the second degree by consanguinity or affinity, as 18 determined under Chapter 573, Government Code, provides the 19 registrar with a signed statement by the person indicating that the 20 21 voter is deceased, and that the secretary of state has adopted a form that may be used to make the signed statement. 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2016. 23
