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| 2 | relating to creation of the Texas Health Improvement Network. |
| 3 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: |
| 4 | SECTION 1. Subtitle H, Title 2, Health & Safety Code, is |
| 5 | amended by adding Chapter 172 to read as follows: |
| 6 | CHAPTER 172. Texas Health Improvement Network |
| 7 | Sec. 172.001. PURPOSE. (a) The Texas Health Improvement |
| 8 | Network (THIN) is established as a network of diverse health |
| 9 | professionals dedicated to developing initiatives and translating |
| 10 | research on population health into health policy and best practices |
| 11 | to address urgent health challenges in Texas and the nation. |
| 12 | (b) The network shall achieve the following goals to improve |
| 13 | the health system: |
| 14 | (1) reduce the per capita costs of health care; |
| 15 | (2) improve the individual experience of care |
| 16 | (including quality and patient satisfaction); and |
| 17 | (3) improve the health of Texas. |
| 18 | Sec. 172.002. NETWORK. (a) The network consists of |
| 19 | participating faculty at public and private Texas institutions of |
| 20 | higher education, in addition to participating state and local |
| 21 | health agencies. Participating faculty must include faculty of |
| 22 | both general academic and health-related institutions. |
| 23 | (b) The network shall seek to include faculty that |
| 24 | represents not only the traditional public health and medical |

- 1 fields, but also expertise on mental health, nursing, pharmacy,
- 2 social work, health economics, health policy and law, epidemiology,
- 3 biostatistics, health informatics, health services research,
- 4 engineering and computer science.
- 5 (c) The network shall focus on evaluating and eliminating
- 6 health disparities in Texas, including the racial or ethnic,
- 7 geographic, and income- or education-related disparities.
- 8 (d) The network shall also focus on healthcare
- 9 cost-containment and the economic analysis of health policy.
- Sec. 172.003. ADVISORY COUNCIL. An advisory council shall
- 11 be established for the network that includes both Texas and
- 12 national thought leaders in population health. The advisory
- 13 council must include expertise in traditional public health and
- 14 medical fields, as well as leaders in the fields of behavior health,
- 15 business, insurance, philanthropy, education, health law, and
- 16 policy.
- Sec. 172.004. PROJECTS. (a) From funds appropriated for
- 18 purposes of the network, the network shall fund demonstration and
- 19 pilot projects using an established, peer-reviewed award process.
- 20 (b) The network shall fund internships and other
- 21 educational programs to prepare population health care workforce.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 the vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
