4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 2, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
6	amended by adding Article 2.139 to read as follows:
7	Art. 2.139. VIDEO RECORDINGS OF ARRESTS FOR INTOXICATION
8	OFFENSES. A person stopped or arrested on suspicion of an offense
9	under Section 49.04, 49.045, 49.07, or 49.08, Penal Code, is
10	entitled to receive from a law enforcement agency employing the
11	peace officer who made the stop or arrest a copy of any video made by
12	or at the direction of the officer that contains footage of:
13	(1) the stop;
14	(2) the arrest;
15	(3) the conduct of the person stopped during any
16	interaction with the officer, including during the administration
17	of a field sobriety test; or
18	(4) a procedure in which a specimen of the person's
19	breath or blood is taken.
20	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
21	to a recording of conduct that occurs on or after the effective date
22	of this Act.
23	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
