2	relating to entities providing engineering services to a utility or

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 1001.002, Occupations Code, is amended
6	by adding Subdivision (3) to read as follows:
7	(3) "Telephony" means the construction, deployment,
8	maintenance or operation of telephones and telephonic systems or
9	telecommunications in which telephonic equipment with or without
10	the use of wires is employed. It includes all design, construction,
11	excavation, trench safety, traffic planning or maintenance

- 12 <u>necessary to design, deploy or maintain such systems in</u>
- 13 rights-of-way, utility easements or private property, but does not
- 14 include constructing or placing a full-size manhole or connecting
- 15 structures between full-size manholes.
- SECTION 2. Section 1001.058, Occupations Code, is amended
- 17 by amending Subdivision (a) to read as follows:
- 18 (a) A regular full-time employee of a privately owned public
- 19 utility or cooperative utility or of the utility's affiliate,
- 20 including any agents or engineering firms performing work on behalf
- 21 of and under the supervision of such utility or affiliate, is exempt
- 22 from the licensing requirements of this chapter if the employee:
- 23 (1) performs services exclusively for the utility or
- 24 affiliate; and

- 1 (2) does not have the final authority to approve, or
- 2 the ultimate responsibility for, engineering designs, plans, or
- 3 specifications that are to be:
- 4 (A) incorporated into fixed works, systems, or
- 5 facilities on the property of others; or
- 6 (B) made available to the public.
- 7 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 8 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 9 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 10 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 11 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
