AN ACT

- 2 relating to defining the occurrence of an interregional conflict
 3 between regional water plans.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 16.001, Water Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subdivision (13) to read as follows:
- 7 (13) "Interregional conflict" means a conflict that
- 8 occurs when:
- 9 (A) more than one adopted regional water plan
- 10 includes the same source of water supply as an identified and
- 11 quantified recommended or alternative water management strategy;
- 12 <u>and</u>

- 13 <u>(B) there is insufficient water available to</u>
- 14 fully implement both water management strategies.
- 15 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 16 of this Act, the Texas Water Development Board shall adopt any rules
- 17 necessary to implement the changes in law made by this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
