A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the establishment of a grant program for promoting computer science certification and professional development for 3 public school teachers. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 21, Education Code, is 7 amended by adding Section 21.417 to read as follows: Sec. 21.417. COMPUTER SCIENCE CERTIFICATION GRANT PROGRAM. 8 (a) The commissioner shall establish a computer science 9 certification grant program to encourage teachers to: 10 11 (1) become certified as computer science teachers; and 12 (2) continue professional development in computer 13 science education. 14 (b) From funds appropriated for that purpose, the commissioner shall make grants to eligible providers that offer: 15 16 (1) training for computer science certification for teachers in accordance with certification requirements adopted by 17 the State Board for Educator Certification; and 18 (2) professional development for currently certified 19 computer science teachers to ensure certified teachers maintain 20 working knowledge of current industry standard tools and resources. 21 (c) To be eligible to receive a grant under this section, a 22 23 provider must: (1) <u>be</u>: 24

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1 (A) an institution of higher education; (B) <u>a regional education service center; or</u> 2 (C) an independent school district or a 3 partnership of multiple independent school districts; and 4 5 (2) meet eligibility standards established by commissioner rule. 6 7 (d) An eligible provider receiving a grant under this section must: 8 (1) provide the training or professional development 9 described by Subsection (b) to teachers in at least three high-need 10 school districts, as determined by commissioner rule; and 11 12 (2) in each school year, successfully provide the training necessary to enable at least 10 teachers to receive 13 14 computer science certification. 15 (e) The commissioner shall adopt rules necessary to implement this section. 16 later 17 SECTION 2. Not than December 31, 2015, the commissioner of education shall establish the grant program 18 required under Section 21.417, Education Code, as added by this 19 Act. 20 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 23 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2015. 25

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
