- 2 relating to the exemption from ad valorem taxation of certain
- 3 tangible personal property used by the owner of the property to
- 4 manufacture, process, or fabricate tangible personal property for

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 11, Tax Code, is amended by
- 8 adding Section 11.36 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 11.36. PROPERTY USED IN MANUFACTURING. The owner of
- 10 tangible personal property that is exempted from the sales and use
- 11 tax under Section 151.318 is entitled to an exemption from ad
- 12 valorem taxation of the appraised value of the property if the
- 13 property is used by the owner to manufacture, process, or fabricate
- 14 tangible personal property for ultimate sale.
- SECTION 2. Section 11.43, Tax Code, is amended by adding
- 16 Subsection (q) to read as follows:
- 17 (q) The application form for an exemption authorized by
- 18 <u>Section 11.36 must require an applicant to submit with the</u>
- 19 application:
- (1) a copy of the issued exemption certificate
- 21 claiming the exemption under Section 151.318 of the property
- 22 described in the application; or
- 23 (2) if the applicant is unable to obtain a copy of the
- 24 exemption certificate described by Subdivision (1), a statement

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- 1 that the property described in the application is exempted from the
- 2 <u>sales and use tax under Section 151.318.</u>
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act applies only to an ad valorem tax year
- 4 that begins on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect January 1, 2016, but only
- 6 if the constitutional amendment proposed by the 84th Legislature,
- 7 Regular Session, 2015, authorizing the legislature to exempt from
- 8 ad valorem taxation by one or more political subdivisions tangible
- 9 personal property used by the owner of the property to manufacture,
- 10 process, or fabricate tangible personal property for ultimate sale
- 11 is approved by the voters. If that amendment is not approved by the
- 12 voters, this Act has no effect.
