9	means a license holder under Chapter 4102, Insurance Code.
10	(b) A public insurance adjuster commits an offense if the
11	public insurance adjuster directly or indirectly solicits
12	employment for an attorney licensed in this state in connection
13	with an insurance claim or insured loss and without having first
14	provided the services customarily undertaken by a public insurance
15	adjuster.
16	(c) A public insurance adjuster commits an offense if the
17	public insurance adjuster, in exchange for referring an insurance
18	claim to an attorney at any time:
19	(1) receives a fee or other compensation from the
20	attorney; or
21	(2) splits a fee or other compensation with the
22	attorney.
23	(d) A public insurance adjuster commits an offense if the
24	public insurance adjuster:

(1) solicits or accepts compensation from, or has a 1 2 financial interest in, any person or entity, including a salvage firm, general contractor, subcontractor, repair firm, or other 3 firm, that obtains business in connection with an insurance claim 4 5 or insured loss that the public insurance adjuster has a contract or 6 agreement to adjust; or 7 (2) refers an insured in connection with an insurance claim or insured loss to any person or entity in which the public 8 insurance adjuster has a financial interest or from whom the public 9 insurance adjuster reasonably expects direct or indirect 10

- 11 compensation as a result of the referral.
- 12 (e) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor.

13 SECTION 2. The heading to Chapter 35, Penal Code, is amended 14 to read as follows:

- 15 CHAPTER 35. INSURANCE FRAUD AND OTHER PROHIBITED CONDUCT
- 16 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
