5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 229, Local Government
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 229.005 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 229.005. CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS FOR GUN SHOW PROMOTERS
8	PROHIBITED IN MUNICIPAL LEASE AGREEMENTS. (a) In this section:
9	(1) "Firearm" has the meaning assigned by Section
10	46.01, Penal Code.
11	(2) "Gun show" means a temporary event held at a public
12	facility at which three or more individuals assemble to display and
13	sell firearms or firearm components to the public.
14	(3) "Gun show promoter" means a person who organizes,
15	plans, promotes, or operates a gun show.
16	(b) Notwithstanding any other law, a municipality that
17	leases a public facility to persons for short-term use for shows,
18	exhibits, or similar purposes may not:
19	(1) refuse to lease the facility to a gun show promoter
20	for the purpose of conducting a gun show;
21	(2) charge a fee to a gun show promoter that is more

- 9 municipality may not include or enforce a provision in the lease
- 10 agreement with the gun show promoter that imposes a condition or
- 11 restriction on the transfer or sale of a firearm at the gun show
- 12 that is not required by federal or state law.
- SECTION 2. Section 229.005(c), Local Government Code, as
- 14 added by this Act, applies only to a lease agreement entered into on
- 15 or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
