- 16 (c) A designation of Westside Drive in El Paso County as the

- 20 <u>(d) The Texas Department of Transportation is not required</u>
- 21 to design, construct, or erect a marker under this section unless a
- 22 grant or donation of funds is made to the department to cover the

- 24 received to cover the cost of the marker shall be deposited to the
