5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 442, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 442.030 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 442.030. DON JUAN DE ONATE TRAIL AS TEXAS HISTORIC
8	HIGHWAY. (a) The commission shall cooperate with the Texas
9	Department of Transportation to designate, interpret, and market
10	Westside Drive in El Paso County as the Don Juan de Onate Trail and a
11	Texas historic highway.
12	(b) To supplement revenue available for the purposes under
13	Subsection (a), the commission and the Texas Department of
14	Transportation may pursue federal funds dedicated to highway
15	enhancement.
16	(c) A designation of Westside Drive in El Paso County as the
17	Don Juan de Onate Trail and a Texas historic highway may not be
18	construed as a designation under the National Historic Preservation
19	Act (16 U.S.C. Section 470 et seq.).
20	(d) The Texas Department of Transportation is not required
21	to design, construct, or erect a marker under this section unless a
22	grant or donation of funds is made to the department to cover the
23	cost of the design, construction, and erection of the marker. Money
24	received to cover the cost of the marker shall be deposited to the

1 credit of the state highway fund.

2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
