17	AIRCRAFT. (a) A writ of assistance for the repossession of an	
18	aircraft authorizes a peace officer to assist and protect a	
19	repossession agent in gaining possession of the aircraft while the	
20	agent:	
21	(1) secures the aircraft on site; or	
22	(2) prepares the aircraft, which may include a	
23	mechanical inspection, for removal from the site by flight or	
24	otherwise to another location.
