## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to a pilot program to expand joint credit programs to
- 3 include certain courses offered by career schools and colleges in
- 4 certain counties.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 132, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 132.026 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 132.026. JOINT CREDIT PILOT PROGRAM. (a) Subject to
- 9 available funding, the commission, in coordination with the Texas
- 10 Education Agency, shall develop and administer a pilot program
- 11 under which the commission awards grants to career schools and
- 12 colleges that partner with participating public high schools to
- 13 offer joint high school and career school or college credit for
- 14 courses in nursing and applied sciences and technology.
- 15 (b) A public high school is eligible to participate in the
- 16 pilot program only if the school is located in an economically
- 17 disadvantaged and underserved region of the state, as determined by
- 18 the commission for purposes of this section.
- (c) To partner with an eligible high school under the pilot
- 20 program, a career school or college must be located in the same
- 21 county as the high school.
- 22 <u>(d) The commission shall award grants under the pilot</u>
- 23 program from funds appropriated for that purpose and any other
- 24 available funds. The commission may seek and accept gifts, grants,

- 1 and donations to fund the pilot program.
- 2 (e) Not later than December 1, 2016, the commission shall
- 3 submit to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the
- 4 house of representatives, and the standing legislative committees
- 5 with primary jurisdiction over education a written report on the
- 6 effectiveness of the pilot program and any recommendations for
- 7 legislative or other action.
- 8 <u>(f) The commission shall adopt rules as necessary to</u>
- 9 implement this section.
- 10 (g) This section expires September 1, 2017.
- 11 SECTION 2. The Texas Workforce Commission shall adopt rules
- 12 for the administration of Section 132.026, Education Code, as added
- 13 by this Act, as soon as practicable after this Act takes effect. For
- 14 that purpose, the commission may adopt the initial rules in the
- 15 manner provided by law for emergency rules.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
