4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 42.012(b), Parks and Wildlife Code, is 6 amended to read as follows:

7 (b) The commission may set a lower fee or waive the fee or license requirement for a resident who is under 17 years old, $\frac{65}{62}$ 8 years old or older, or participating in an event that is sponsored 9 or co-sponsored by the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department with the 10 approval of the executive director. The commission shall waive the 11 12 fee for a qualified disabled veteran and for a resident on active duty as a member of the United States military forces, the Texas 13 14 Army National Guard, the Texas Air National Guard, or the Texas State Guard.. 15
