## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to an optional bad weather policy for public schools.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 25.081, Education Code, is amended by
5	adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
6	(c) The board of trustees of each school district that
7	exceeds the full 7 hours of instructional time required by Section
8	25.082(a) by at least one half hour daily for the full academic year
9	may adopt a policy to credit the additional time to the number of
10	instructional days required by Subsection (a). The excess time may
11	be accumulated in amounts up to but not exceeding ten (10) days each
12	year for days missed due to dangerous or extreme weather
13	conditions. Unused accumulated days for excess instructional time
14	shall not carry over to a school year other than the year in which
15	the time was accumulated. After a district credits each day in
16	accordance with this subsection, the district shall notify the
17	commissioner in writing.
18	SECTION 2. Section 42.005, Education Code, is amended by
19	adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
20	(a-1) For any school day credited in accordance with Section
21	25.081(c), the daily attendance shall be reported as the quotient
22	calculated under Subsection (a)(1).
23	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
