- Sec. 161.089. NEIGHBORHOOD AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT PLANS 7
- FOR GROUP HOMES. (a) For purposes of this section, "group home" 8
- 9 means:

- (1) a residence in which residential support or 10
- supervised living is provided through the Home and Community-Based 11
- Services waiver program; or 12
- 13 (2) a residence in which fewer than seven persons
- 14 reside and in which services are provided through the intermediate
- care facility for individuals with an intellectual disability or 15
- 16 related condition program.
- (b) An operator of a group home shall develop and maintain a 17
- neighborhood and community engagement plan to promote positive 18

- 21 (1) address barriers to and facilitate meaningful
