5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 39.023, Education Code, is amended by
7	adding Subsections (a-11) and (a-12) to read as follows:
8	(a-11) Before an assessment instrument adopted or developed
9	under Subsection (a) may be administered under that subsection,
10	the assessment instrument must, on the basis of empirical evidence,
11	be determined to be valid and reliable by an entity that is
12	independent of the agency and of any other entity that developed the
13	assessment instrument.
14	(a-12) The agency shall ensure that an assessment
15	instrument adopted or developed under Subsection (a) is designed
16	only to assess student understanding of the essential knowledge and
17	skills identified by the State Board of Education under Section
18	28.002 of the subject and for the grade level for which the
19	assessment instrument is administered.
20	(a-13) An assessment instrument adopted or developed under
21	Subsection (a) may be used only for purposes:
22	(1) for which the assessment instrument is designed;
23	and
24	(2) for which, on the basis of empirical evidence, the

- 1 <u>assessment instrument is determined to be valid and reliable by an</u>
- 2 entity that is independent of the agency and of any other entity
- 3 that developed the assessment instrument.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
- 5 school year.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- $7\,$ a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
