- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 2001.058, Government Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 8 (g) Notwithstanding Subsection (e) or any other law, in a
- 9 contested case before a state agency that concerns licensing in
- 10 relation to an occupational license and is not disposed of by
- 11 stipulation, agreed settlement, or consent order, an occupational
- 12 <u>license holder may elect to have the administrative law judge</u>
- 13 render the final decision in the contested case. If the license
- 14 holder elects to have the administrative law judge render the final
- 15 decision, the provisions applicable to a contested case under
- 16 Subsection (f) apply to a contested case described by this
- 17 <u>subsection.</u>
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 19 to a contested case filed on or after the effective date of this
- 20 Act. A contested case filed before the effective date of this Act
- 21 is governed by the law in effect on the date the contested case was
- 22 filed, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
