- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 61.003(a), Government Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (a) Each person who reports for jury service shall be
- 7 personally provided a form letter that when signed by the person
- 8 directs the county treasurer to donate all, or a specific amount
- 9 designated by the person, of the person's daily reimbursement under
- 10 this chapter to:
- 11 (1) the compensation to victims of crime fund under
- 12 Subchapter B, Chapter 56, Code of Criminal Procedure;
- 13 (2) the child welfare, child protective services, or
- 14 child services board of the county appointed under Section 264.005,
- 15 Family Code, that serves abused and neglected children;
- 16 (3) any program selected by the commissioners court
- 17 that is operated by a public or private nonprofit organization and
- 18 that provides shelter and services to victims of family violence;

- 20 (4) any other program approved by the commissioners
- 21 court of the county, including a program established under Article
- 22 56.04(f), Code of Criminal Procedure, that offers psychological
- 23 counseling to jurors in criminal cases involving graphic evidence

- 1 (5) a veterans court program established by the
- 2 <u>commissioners court as provided by Chapter 124</u>.
- 3 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 4 to donations from jurors appearing in response to a summons issued
- 5 on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
