AN ACT

- 2 relating to the regulation of certain private security companies 3 and occupations.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1702.230, Occupations Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) An application for registration or endorsement must be 8 verified and include:
- 9 (1) the applicant's full name, residence address,
- 10 residence telephone number, date and place of birth, and social
- 11 security number;

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- 12 (2) a statement that:
- 13 (A) lists each name used by the applicant, other
- 14 than the name by which the applicant is known at the time of
- 15 application, and an explanation stating each place where each name
- 16 was used, the date of each use, and a full explanation of the
- 17 reasons the name was used; or
- 18 (B) states that the applicant has never used a
- 19 name other than the name by which the applicant is known at the time
- 20 of application;
- 21 (3) the name and address of the applicant's employer
- 22 and, if applicable, the applicant's consulting firm;
- 23 (4) the date the employment commenced;
- 24 (5) a letter from the license holder requesting that

- 1 the applicant be registered or endorsed;
- 2 (6) the title of the position occupied by the
- 3 applicant and a description of the applicant's duties; [and]
- 4 (7) all required fees, including the criminal history
- 5 check fee;
- 6 (8) fingerprints in the form and manner approved by
- 7 the department, and verified as required by subsection (d) of this
- 8 section; and
- 9 (9) any other information, evidence, statement, or
- 10 document required by the board.
- 11 (b) The employer of the applicant shall make a reasonable
- 12 attempt to verify the information required under Subsection (a)(1)
- 13 before the earlier of:
- 14 (1) the date the application is submitted; or
- 15 (2) the date the applicant begins to perform the
- 16 duties of employment that require registration.
- 17 (c) An applicant must submit an application that
- 18 substantially meets the requirements of this section prior to
- 19 employment in a capacity for which registration is required.
- 20 (d) Subsection (a)(8) of this section requires the
- 21 department receive electronic verification from the Federal Bureau
- 22 of Investigation or the department's Crime Records Service that
- 23 <u>fingerprints have been submitted</u>.
- (e) The department shall make available to the public
- 25 <u>information on whether an applicant has met the conditions</u>
- 26 necessary to perform regulated services.
- 27 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
