5	SECTION 1. Article 49.10, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
6	amended by amending Subsections (b), (g), and (h) and adding
7	Subsections (b-1), (g-1), and (h-1) to read as follows:
8	(b) For a body or body part found outside the boundaries of a
9	municipality, the [The] commissioners court of the county shall pay
10	a reasonable fee for a consultation obtained by a justice of the
11	peace under Subsection (a) of this article.
12	(b-1) For a body or body part found within the boundaries of
13	a municipality, the municipality shall pay a reasonable fee for a
14	consultation obtained by a justice of the peace under Subsection
15	(a) of this article.
16	(g) For a body or body part found outside the boundaries of a
17	municipality, the [The] commissioners court shall pay a reasonable
18	fee to a physician performing an autopsy on the order of a justice
19	of the peace, if a fee is assessed.
20	(g-1) For a body or body part found within the boundaries of
21	a municipality, the municipality shall pay a reasonable fee to a
22	physician performing an autopsy on the order of a justice of the
23	peace, if a fee is assessed.
24	(h) For a body or body part found outside the boundaries of a

<u>municipality, the</u> [The] commissioners court shall pay a reasonable fee for the transportation of <u>the</u> [a] body <u>or body part</u> to a place where an autopsy can be performed under this article if a justice of the peace orders the body <u>or body part</u> to be transported to the place.

6 (h-1) For a body or body part found within the boundaries of 7 a municipality, the municipality shall pay a reasonable fee for the 8 transportation of the body or body part to a place where an autopsy 9 can be performed under this article if a justice of the peace orders 10 the body or body part to be transported to the place.

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to an autopsy ordered on or after the effective date of this Act. An autopsy ordered before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the autopsy was ordered, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

16 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
