18	(2) "Political subdivision" means a county,
19	municipality, school district, junior college district, other
20	special district, or other subdivision of state government.
21	(b) A political subdivision that maintains an Internet

website must post on the website each economic development

agreement that the political subdivision enters into. The political

subdivision must post each agreement continuously from the date the

- 2 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding Section 500.001, Local
- 3 Government Code, as added by this Act, a political subdivision must
- 4 post each economic development agreement as defined by that section
- 5 that is in effect on the effective date of this Act not later than
- 6 December 1, 2015.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
