- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 18, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Article 18.24 to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 18.24. BODY CAVITY SEARCH. (a) In this article, "body
- 8 cavity search" means an inspection that is conducted of a person's
- 9 <u>anal or vaginal cavity in any manner.</u>
- 10 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, a peace officer may not
- 11 conduct a body cavity search of a person arrested or detained during
- 12 the investigation of a criminal offense unless a magistrate has
- 13 <u>issued a search warrant pursuant to this chapter authorizing the</u>
- 14 body cavity search.
- 15 (c) A person who is not arrested and charged with an offense
- 16 arising out of evidence obtained incident to a body cavity search
- 17 shall not be held responsible for medical expenses incident to the
- 18 body cavity search.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect November 1, 2015.
