- 10 written request not later than the third working day after the date
- 11 the party receives notice of:
- 12 <u>(1)</u> the substance of the associate judge's report as

- 14 (2) the rendering of the temporary order, if the
- 15 request concerns a temporary order rendered by an associate judge
- 16 <u>under Section 201.007(a)(14)(C)</u>.
