H.B. No. 4088

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the Texas enterprise fund. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 481.078, Government Code is amended by 4 5 adding Subsection (m) as follows: (m) In a calendar year at least 35 percent of the grant 6 agreements entered into must contain a provision that requires all 7 of the jobs created under the agreement to be created: 8 9 (1) in an area designated as a Qualified Census Tract (QCTs) as defined by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban 10 11 Development (HUD); and 12 (2) target and promote appropriate size companies of approximately 25 employees or more. 13 SECTION 2. Section 481.079, Government Code is amended as 14 follows: 15 Sec. 481.079. REPORT ON USE OF MONEY IN TEXAS ENTERPRISE 16 FUND. (a) Before the beginning of each regular session of the 17 legislature, the governor shall submit to the lieutenant governor, 18 the speaker of the house of representatives, and each other member 19 20 of the legislature a report on grants made under Section 481.078 21 that states: 22 (1) the number of direct jobs each recipient committed 23 to create in this state, regional and under Section 481.078 (m); 24 (2) the number of direct jobs each recipient created

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1 in this state, regional and under Section 481.078 (m); 2 (3) the median wage of the jobs each recipient created 3 in this state, regional and under Section 481.078 (m); 4 (4) measures the typical lifespan of the jobs each 5 recipient created; 6 (5) whether the jobs created each recipient created 7 are generally aligned with the skill levels of the residents in the 8 area where the jobs are created 9 (4) (6) the amount of capital investment each 10 recipient committed to expend or allocate per project in this state, regional and under Section 481.078 (m); 11 12 (5) (7) the amount of capital investment each recipient expended or allocated per project in this state, regional 13 14 and under Section 481.078 (m); 15 (6) (8) the total amount of grants made to each 16 recipient; 17 (7) (9) the average amount of money granted in this state for each job created in this state, regional and under 18 19 Section 481.078 (m) by grant recipients; (8) (10) the number of jobs created in this state by 20 grant recipients in each sector of the North American Industry 21 Classification System (NAICS); and 22 23 (9) (11) of the number of direct jobs each recipient 24 created in this state, regional and under Section 481.078 (m), the number of positions created that provide health benefits for 25 26 employees. (a-1) For grants awarded for a purpose specified by Section 27

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1 <u>481.078</u>(d-1), the report must include only the amount and purpose 2 of each grant.

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3 (b) The report may not include information that is made 4 confidential by law.

5 (c) The governor may require a recipient of a grant under 6 Section <u>481.078</u> to submit, on a form the governor provides, 7 information required to complete the report

8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
