A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the compensation of public school district employees
- 3 for additional workdays.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 22, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 22.012 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 22.012. COMPENSATION FOR ADDITIONAL WORKDAY. (a) Not
- 8 later than May 1 of each year, a school district shall publish an
- 9 official calendar for the following school year that specifies each
- 10 day that is an official workday for school district employees.
- 11 (b) If a school district employee is required to work on
- 12 additional days that are not identified as workdays on the calendar
- 13 published as required by Subsection (a), the district shall
- 14 compensate the employee for the additional days.
- 15 (c) A school district must compensate an employee for each
- 16 additional day of work in an amount not less than the greater of:
- 17 (1) the amount that the school district would deduct
- 18 from the employee's annual salary if the employee accrued an
- 19 <u>absence beyond the employee's available personal leave;</u>
- 20 (2) a daily rate, calculated by dividing the
- 21 employee's annual salary by the number of workdays specified in the
- 22 calendar required under Subsection (a); or
- 23 (3) the same rate by which the annual salary of the
- 24 employee may be reduced as provided by Section 21.4021(b).

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- 1 (d) A school district may not take any action that results
- 2 in a longer workday for a school district employee to comply with
- 3 this section.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
