1 AN ACT 2 relating to bond elections for the Lynn County Hospital District. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 1054.201, Special District Local Laws 4 5 Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 The board may issue and sell general obligation bonds in the name and on the faith and credit of the district to: 7 (1) purchase, construct, acquire, repair, or renovate 8

- 9 buildings or improvements;10 (2) equip buildings or improvements for hospital
- 11 purposes; or
- 12 (3) acquire and operate a mobile emergency medical 13 service.
- (b) No bonds shall be issued by the hospital district 14 except refunding bonds until authorized by a majority of the 15 qualified property taxpaying electors. The order for the bond 16 election shall specify the date of the election, the amount of bonds 17 to be authorized, the maximum maturity of the bonds, the maximum 18 rate of interest they are to bear, the place or places where the 19 election shall be held, the presiding judge and alternate judge for 20 21 each voting place and provide for clerks as in the county elections. Notice of any bond election, except one held under the 22 23 provisions of Section 8, in which instance notice shall be given as provided in Section 3, shall be given as provided in Article 704, 24

- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
