## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the allocation of low income housing tax credits set 3 aside for at-risk developments. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 2306.6714, Government Code, is amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows: 6 7 (c) Except as otherwise provided by federal law and notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, in allocating 8 9 housing tax credits set aside under Subsection (a), the department may not consider: 10 11 (1) the poverty rate or area median income in the 12 census tract in which the development is located; or 13 (2) the presence of blight three miles or less from the 14 development. SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 15 to low income housing tax credits that are awarded by the Texas 16 Department of Housing and Community Affairs during an application 17 cycle that begins on or after the effective date of this Act. A low 18 income housing tax credit that is awarded during an application 19 cycle that began before the effective date of this Act is governed 20 21 by the law in effect on the date the application cycle began, and 22 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015. 23

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
